How can I share the Google Forms with learners?

Answer:

- 1. If the learners are not with you in the classroom, click Preview, copy the link and email it to them, or send it per Whatsapp.
- 2. If the learners are with you in the classroom, I would like to suggest the following: Shorten the URL or create a QR code (See the web addresses in the slide below)



How do you set the time for a learner to do the test at home? Do the children then get a notice about the time the test is available?

Answer:

- 1. In the Add-ons section (Where you set the questions) there are timers to choose from.
- 2. But I have done something else recently: We have sent the link for the test to the learners and told them that the test will be open from 15:00 until 16:00. The at 15:00 I opened the test and at 16:00 I closed it again. It is a manual procedure, but as switching a light on or off.





How do I go about typing formulae of compounds and mathematical expressions?


Answer:

In Word/Excel/Powerpoint you can do the following:

- 1. Click Insert
- 2. Then go to Symbols on the far right of your screen and click Equations.



- 3. Select the one you need.
- 4. You may also click on the lnk option. Then you can write the equation using your mouse (or finger if you have a touch screen) and it will be converted to a type font.
- 5. If you want to put it in Google Forms, use your **Snipping Tool** to cut it and change it to a picture and then insert at.



6. Some colleagues mentioned *Equation*, but I do not have experience of that.





Is there any capability for graphic questions - and graphic answers (in music we often ask the kids to encircle parts of written music)?

Answer:

You should use your Computer's **Snipping Tool** to cut that specific part from the original soft copy on your computer and then save it as a picture. Then you import it to the place where you want it in your test. As part of the question or as an option of a multiple-choice question. In other words, it is most likely that you will not be able to type the Musical Notation in Google Forms but you can cut and paste it.

There are very few musical characters as part of the ordinary Font sets on the computer, e.g. ightharpoonup

However, there are free Music Fonts available on the Internet. (Just Google and try and find a suitable one.)
