## **CIRCULAR S13 OF 2021**

REPEAL OF ADDITIONAL READING AND PLANNING TIME FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT) NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE (NSC) EXAMINATION

- Circular S4 of 2021 released the Abridged version of Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS) Grade 12 for implementation in January 2021.
- 2. It was indicated in the Abridged version of the CAPS that IT learners will receive 30 minutes reading and planning time before commencement of the practical examination.
- 3. The additional 30 minutes planning and reading time as stipulated in Section 4 of CAPs for IT P1 is withdrawn.

4. However, provision will be made in the examination for learners to do planning

and this will be factored into the 3-hour examination time. Learners will also

receive two blank pages as part of the examination paper to use for planning

purposes during the 3-hour examination.

5. In addition, the same provision will be made for Computer Applications

Technology (CAT) learners by factoring planning time into the 3-hour

examination time and providing two blank pages as part of the examination

paper for planning purposes during the 3-hour examination.

6. Details will be provided to PEDs and candidates via the circular for the conduct

of practical examinations to be released in due course.
