BRIDGES are constructed for the **purpose of providing passage over obstacles**, which is usually something that is otherwise difficult or impossible to cross.









LEADERSHIP IS NOT A POSITION –

1st century BC, the roman consul, Cicero: "The leaders should all relate to this principle. The governed should must be as happy as possible"




1st century, Jesus: "The greatest among you, must be a servant"


