Difference between Discipline and punishment

Discipline	Punishment
Gives a positive outcome	Tells what to do without reason
Recognition and reward for positive behaviour	Emphasis on bad behaviour
Takes learners view in regard	Learner is not involved
Constant firm leadership	In control and embarrassing
Positive and promotes respect	Negative and regularly disrespectful
Non aggressive	Aggressive
Learner learns the why	Only learns to follow rules blindly
Understands learners' abilities, needs and development.	One size fits all
Learns self-discipline	Dependent on authority
Accepts mistakes as learning opportunities	Mistakes are not acceptable
Focusses on learners behaviour rather than personality	Criticizes learners personality rather than behaviour.
