Baby message	Baby massage is gentle, rhythmic stroking of your baby's body with your hands
socially	In company of others, in a social manner for pleasure
physically	Relating to the body instead of the mind of the child
Sensory play	Includes any activity that stimulates a young child's senses of touch, smell, taste, sight, and hearing.
learning	The acquisition of knowledge or skills through study, experience, or being taught.
Sensory	Sensation or the physical senses, transmitted or perceived by the senses.
